**\*All awards are one-time scholarships - distributed in July/August prior to the first year of college. The scholarship checks will be distributed by Dave Hughes (on behalf of the MOC-FV Foundation) from NW Bank in Orange City after he receives a copy of the first college bill from the student prior to July 19.**

**\*IMPORTANT TIPS!! Ask reference people in person, nicely, give them plenty of time, send them the URL link, remind nicely, and thank them. Write essays with your best effort. READ DIRECTIONS/DEADLINES CAREFULLY!!**

**Paul Aykens Service** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply; service to school, community, church; scholarship; activity involvement; honors/awards; character; any college; ACT score; GPA; transcript; 75 words or less essay; one reference form; \$750 each

**Todd & Connie Barry** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply with additional consideration given to boys'/girls' BB player &/or future health-related career; moral & Christian character; attitude & sportsmanship; leadership; citizenship; involvement; grades; ACT score; transcript; any college; 150 words or less essay; \$500

**Warren DeVries** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply; scholarship; activity involvement; honors/awards; community activities; service; character; attending NWC; GPA; ACT; 2 reference forms; \$500 each

**Pat Hansen Iowa Community College** – MOC-FV seniors planning to attend an Iowa community college; 3 brief essay questions; any college; \$500

**Jim Kleis Memorial Scholarship** – MOC-FV seniors planning to attend Northwestern College with a major in teacher education; based upon - GPA, ACT, and a brief essay; \$750

**Gail Marincovich Creative Arts** – passion for arts; involvement in arts; future college major & career in the arts; any college; "arts" – writing, theatre, visual arts, literature, speech, dance, or music; 2 brief essays; \$500

**Gordon McKinstrey Coaching/Education** – future coach/educator; character; attitude & scholarship; citizenship; leadership; participation in sports & music; attending NWC or BVU; 2 reference forms; \$500

**Patricia Ver Steeg-Fedders Healthcare** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply with additional consideration given to those pursuing a degree and career in healthcare; scholarship; activity involvement; character; community involvement; any college; GPA; ACT; 1 brief essay; up to \$500 each

**Harding Family** - Multiple scholarships up to \$2,500 will be awarded to graduating seniors with the total amount of each award dependent upon the annual proceeds received. Any senior may apply, but additional consideration will be given to students interested in pursuing areas of study in agriculture, and life sciences. (examples: agronomy, agriculture, agri-business, agri-technology, ag-education, turf management animal science, biology, nutrition, genetics and microbiology, and other earth/plant science majors may also be considered.) Awards based upon: major, college plans to any college, essay, activities/employment/service, financial need.
