

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the central administration office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members present. De Jong and Reyes were present electronically. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Principals Landhuis, De Graaf, Smith, and Mulder, Secretary Dykstra and the press.

The meeting was called to order at 5:03 p.m. by President Jager.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink and seconded by Koerselman to approve the agenda as mailed. Motion carried unanimously.

President Jager announced that this is the time, place and date to hold a public hearing on the issuance of bid documents for Bid Issuance #1 (Earthwork) for the Elementary School Project. Since there were no objectors, the president declared the hearing closed.
