

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL - - - - February 8, 2021

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members in attendance. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, and the press.

President Jager called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Koerselman to approve the agenda as mailed. Carried unanimously.

President Jager announced that this is the time, place, and date to hold a public hearing regarding the school calendar for 2021-22. Since there were no objectors, the president declared the hearing closed.

- David Pfaffle at a rate of \$70 per student to provide 15 days of classroom instruction for driver's education for the summer of 2021
- Payroll advice statements at the rate of \$180.00 per student to the following instructors, who will drive with the students: Neil Bracker, Dave Pfaffle, Jennifer Lambert, Evangelyn De Jong, Karl Bahrke, Zach Schaver, and Jake Byma

An update was given on the new elementary building project by W.A. Klinger.

Motion by Kleinhesselink, supported by Koerselman to approve the Resolution Directing the Sale of \$400,000 Taxable School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Subordinate Series 2021. Motion carried unanimously. The district has an interest-free loan from Northwest REC that allows for the geothermal HVAC system.

Motion by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to approve the Resolution Authorizing the Terms of Issuance and Providing for and Securing the Payment of Taxable School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Subordinate Series 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kleinhesselink and supported by Reyes to approve the engagement with Piper-Sandler as the fiscal agent for the issuance of Sales Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2021A. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by De Jong and supported by Kleinhesselink to approve the engagement with Ahlers & Cooney P.C. as the bond counsel and disclosure counsel for the issuance of Sales Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2021A. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Reyes, supported by De Jong to approve the Resolution Fixing Date for a Hearing on the Proposed Issuance of Approximately \$6,100,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services, and Use Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds. Motion carried unanimously. The public hearing has been sent for March 8, 2021 at 5:00 in the district board room.

Motion by Kleinhesselink and supported by Koerselman to approve the engagement with Ahlers & Cooney P.C. as the bond counsel and disclosure counsel for the issuance for General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2021. Motion carried unanimously.

Kleinhesselink left the meeting at 6:03 p.m.

Graham Forbes, representing Williams and Company, presented the 2019-20 audit report. Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Koerselman to approve the 2019-20 audit report. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reyes, supported by De Jong and carried unanimously to approve the following board policies:

Superintendent Adams shared information about the CAPS Program Engagement/Training happening on February 16.

The first reading of Board Policies 504.8-504.14 was presented.

Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Koerselman to approve Board Policy Title: School Calendar, Code No. 601.2 for the 2021-22 school year. School will begin on August 23 and end on May 24 for a total of 180 classroom days and 191 contract days. The calendar is based upon the 1,080 hours of instruction method with the understanding that any full days missed will be made up. Commencement is set for May 29, 2022. Motion carried unanimously. See attachment.

Motion by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to approve the orchestra trip to Chicago for the spring of 2022. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Reyes and supported by Koerselman to approve the scheduling of the middle school trip to Washington D.C. and New York City in 2022 and cancellation for students who have missed the previous two trips. Motion carried unanimously.

At 6:43 p.m., motion was made by De Jong and supported by Reyes to enter closed session as provided by Chapter 20.17(3) of the open meetings law for a negotiations strategy session. Jager-aye, De Jong-aye, Koerselman-aye, and Reyes-aye.

The meeting reconvened in regular session at 7:11 p.m.

Motion by Koerselman, supported by De Jong to approve the hiring of an additional 1.5 FTE teaching positions for the 2021-22 school year. Motion carried unanimously.
