

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS - - - - May 10, 2021

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members in attendance except Reyes. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, and the press.

President Jager called the meeting to order at 5:03 p.m.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink and supported by Koerselman to approve the agenda with the addition of an industrial tech student report. Motion carried unanimously.

President Jager announced that this is the time, place and date to hold a hearing on the proposed 2020-21 budget amendment. Superintendent Adams explained that the 2020-21 budget is being amended due to the summer food program and the SAVE refunding bonds. Since there were no objectors, the president declared the hearing closed.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink, supported by De Jong and carried unanimously to deny the Open Enrollment of Chase Sassman out of the MOC-Floyd Valley Community School District into the Boyden-Hull Community School District for the 2020-21 school year for the next year and a half, since it was received after the March 2 deadline.

Tim Oswald, from Piper Sandler, presented the consideration of sealed bids opened and reviewed by the Superintendent of Schools, Secretary of the Board, and the Financial Advisor.

Motion by De Jong, supported by Reyes to approve Resolution Directing the Sale of Approximately \$9,995,000 General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2021. De Jong-aye, Jager-aye, Kleinhesselink-aye, Koerselman-aye and Reyes-aye.

An update was given on the new elementary building project by W.A. Klinger.

Mr. Bonnema and a student shared an industrial tech presentation.
