- Contract for Lindsey Hoekstra as classroom aide for 6.25 hours per day, not to exceed 129 hours per month, at a salary of \$14.04 per hour based upon the 1st step of the 2021-22 non-certified salary schedule
- Open enrollment of Emely Lopez Lopez out of the MOC-Floyd Valley Community School District into the Sioux Center Community School District for the 2021-22 school year for the next thirteen years

Grant Hegstad shared information on the CAPS program.

An update was given on the new elementary building project and proposed high school addition.

Jager left the meeting 5:55 p.m. and Vice-President Kleinhesselink presided over the meeting.

Kristen Puttmann, Michelle Te Grootenhuys, and Beth Oolman provided the board with a district literacy and language arts report.

Bids were sent out for a new school bus. Two bids were received: Thomas for \$148,450 and Blue Bird for \$144,993. Motion by Koerselman, supported by De Jong to approve the purchase of 2 new school buses from Blue Bird for \$144,993 each. Motion carried unanimously.

A monthly progress report was given by the building principals.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Reyes and carried unanimously to approve the following Board Policies:

The board reviewed the Return-to-Learn plan.

The first reading of Board Policies 702.6-702.11 was presented.

Motion by Reyes, supported by Koerselman to approve the price increase of an adult meal to \$3.95 as required by the USDA Child Nutrition Program effective January 1, 2022. Motion carried

unanimously.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$266,321 due to an increase of certified enrollment from the prior year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reyes, supported by Koerselman to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$39,514 related to the English language learning program for students who have exceeded five years of weighting that are included on the Fall 2021 certified enrollment headcount. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Koerselman, supported by De Jong to approve the request for bids for the MOC-Floyd Valley Community School District Middle School HVAC Retrofit and High School Commons Cooling. Motion carried unanimously.

At 7:25 p.m., motion was made by Koerselman and supported by De Jong to enter closed session as provided by Chapter 20.17(3) of the open meetings law for a superintendent evaluation. De Jong—aye, Kleinhesselink—aye, Koerselman—aye and Reyes—aye.

The meeting reconvened in regular session at 8:21 p.m. and immediately adjourned.
