

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL - - - - October 10, 2022

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the MOC-Floyd Valley Middle School library for its regular monthly meeting. All members of the board were present except Koerselman and Reyes. Also in attendance were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, Principals Mulder, Yaw, Landhuis, and De Graaf as well as the press.

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. by President Jager.

Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Kleinhesselink to approve the agenda as mailed. Motion carried unanimously.

Reyes joined the meeting at 5:04 p.m.

President Jager announced that this is the time, place and date to hold a hearing on the sale of Hospers Elementary Property. Since there were no objectors, the president declared the hearing closed.

An update was given on the new elementary building and high school renovation project.

Chris Krohn provided the board with a written updated on health and physical education.

Adam Boone presented a report on his work supporting students and staff at the middle school in his instructional coach role.

Mark Gunderson, athletic director, shared the district's plans for girls' wrestling.

A monthly progress report was given by the building principals.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Reyes and carried unanimously to approve the 200 series of the Board Policies.

The board reviewed the Return-to-Learn plan.

Tentative information was presented on the certified enrollment, showing decrease from the prior year.

The first reading was presented of the board policies in the 300 series and 805.5.

Motion by Kleinhesselink, supported by Reyes to approve the sale of the Hospers Elementary property to the City of Hospers for \$65,000. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Reyes, supported by De Jong to approve the MOC-Floyd Valley District Playbook and Goals for the 2022-2023 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Kleinhesselink and supported by De Jong to approve the Superintendent's goals for the school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by De Jong and supported by Ryes to approve the bid from DKOI Signs for a digital sign for the new elementary property for \$28,573.50. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by De Jong, supported by Kleinhesselink to approve Unity Christian replacing George-Little Rock in the Siouxland Conference and remaining a 10-team conference starting in the 2023-2024 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by De Jong and supported by Reyes to approve the fundraiser for the high school musical production of Disney's The Little Mermaid. Motion carried unanimously.
