The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members in attendance. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, building principals, and the press.

Motion by De Jong and supported by Koerselman to approve the purchase of the mower from Marv's Outdoor Power Equipment & Sharpening for \$33,254.41. Motion carried unanimously.
