The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the central administration office for a special session with all board members present. Also present was Gary Richardson from Grieves Richardson LLC and Secretary Dykstra. The purpose of the special meeting was to conduct interviews for the position of superintendent.

President Jager called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m.

Superintendent candidate interviewed was Mike Mulder.

At 4:02 p.m., motion was made by Kleinhesselink and supported by Koerselman to enter closed session as provided by Chapter 21.5(i) of the open meetings law to evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose hiring is being considered to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual has requested a closed session. Fernstrum-aye, Jager-aye, Kleinhesselink-aye, Koerselman-aye, Reyes-aye.

At 6:10 p.m., the meeting resumed in regular session.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink and supported by Reyes to extend a contract to Mike Mulder for the position of superintendent in the amount of \$155,000 effective July 1, 2024, along with administrative benefits. Motion carried unanimously.
