

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL - - - - January 8, 2024

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members in attendance. Jager and Koerselman were present electronically. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, and the press.

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m. by Vice-President Kleinhesselink. Kleinhesselink ran the meeting since Jager was not present in person.

Motion by Reyes and supported by Fernstrum to approve the agenda with the addition of the names for student recognition. Motion carried unanimously.

Received a letter for initiation to bargain from the MOC-Floyd Valley Education Association for the 2024-2025 Master Contract.

The board reviewed the Return-to-Learn plan.

The first reading was made for Board Policies 506.1-508.2.

Motion by Fernstrum, supported by Reyes and carried unanimously to approve the At-Risk and Dropout Prevention Program for the 2024-2025 school year as follows:

- Success Center at the high school including salaries, benefits and software
- Intensive counseling at all grade levels including salaries and benefits
- Secondary Academic Support including salaries, benefits, software and supplies
- Elementary Academic Support including salaries, benefits, software and supplies

Motion was made by Fernstrum and supported by Reyes to approve request to the School Budget Review Committee (SBRC) for Modified Supplemental Amount and Supplemental Aid for the 2024-2025 Dropout Prevention Program in the amount of \$437,309, for expenditures necessary to implement the 2024-2025 at-risk and dropout prevention program plans as approved by the MOC-Floyd Valley CSD school board. Fernstrum-aye, Kleinhesselink-aye, Koerselman-aye, Reyes-aye.

Motion was made by Fernstrum and supported by Reyes to approve Board Policy Title: School Calendar, Code No. 601.2 for the 2024-25 school year. School will begin on August 23 and end on May 29 for a total of 180 classroom days and 191 contract days. The calendar is based upon the 1,080 hours of instruction method with the understanding that any full days missed will be made up. Commencement date will be May 25. Motion carried unanimously.
