

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS-----February 26, 2024

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the central administration office for a special session with all board members present. Also present were Gary Richardson from Grieves Richardson LLC and Secretary Dykstra. The purpose of the special meeting was to conduct interviews for the high school principal position.

President Jager called the meeting to order at 4:57 p.m.

Motion was made by Reyes and supported by Koerselman to approve the agenda as mailed. Carried unanimously.

- Resignation from Gumaro Sanchez as high school custodian, effective at the end of the summer
- Resignation from Mike Mulder as high school boys' basketball assistant coach, effective at the end of the school year
- Resignation from Joan Brower as middle school teacher, effective at the end of the school year
- Contract for Carlee Harmelink as .5 FTE high school Spanish teacher and .5 FTE ELL teacher for the 2024-25 school year at a salary of \$44,602
- Contract for Parker Mulder as high school teacher for the 2024-25 school year at a salary of \$55,000
- Contract for Parker Mulder for assistant high school boys' basketball coach for the 2024-2025 school year at a salary of \$3,744 based upon Level II of the 2023-24 supplement salary schedule
