Motion made by Schutt and supported by Jager to accept the bid from Hoogendoorn Construction for the Athletic Complex with the agreed upon value-engineering as well as the agreed upon financial contributions from Northwestern College and the City of Orange City. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Schutt and supported by Kleinhesselink to accept the bid from Hoogendoorn Construction for the Auditorium/Family Consumer Science Room/Library Project at the high school for \$1,779,000 minus the alternate of \$37,000 for a total of \$1,742,000. Motion carried unanimously.
