Superintendent Adams gave a legislative update and included information on smarter balance assessments.

Motion was made by Immecker and supported by Koerselman to approve the SBRC Application for open-enrolled out students in the amount of \$122,474 and LEP Instruction Beyond 5 years in the amount of \$32,094.04 for a grand total of \$154,568.04. Motion carried unanimously.
