Consideration was given on hiring a .5 FTE school nurse. Motion by Koerselman, supported by Reyes to approve the addition of a .5 FTE school nurse position. Motion carried unanimously.

A concrete quote was received for paving areas throughout the district from Jellema Construction for \$41,843: Hospers Elementary-\$10,387, Orange City Elementary-\$5,187, Middle School-\$5,316, High School-\$20,953. A suggestion was made to postpone the concrete replacement at the high school. Motion was made by Reyes and supported by Immeker to accept the concrete quote from Jellema Construction for \$20,890 for both elementary schools and the middle school. Motion carried unanimously.

The district has been working with the City of Alton to repair the north side bus loading area at the middle school. The City is working with Jellema Construction to install curb and gutter. A concrete bid was received

from Jellema Construction for \$34,926 to repair the north side bus loading area as well as the sidewalk entry at the middle school. Motion by Immeker, supported by Koerselman to accept the concrete bid from Jellema Construction for \$34,926. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Reyes and supported by Koerselman to approve the transportation agreement with Mid-Sioux Opportunity Head Start for the 2018-19 school year. Motion carried unanimously.

Bids were received for 630 Chromebooks to be used for grades 8-12: FireFly Computers-\$172,620, Sterling Computers-\$172,437.30, and STS Education-\$184,905. Motion by Immeker, supported by Reyes to approve the purchase of the Chromebooks from Sterling Computers for \$172,437.30. Motion carried unanimously.
