

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL - - - - February 10, 2020

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members in attendance, except Kleinhesselink and Reyes. Also present were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra, and the press.

President Jager called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Koerselman to approve the agenda with the addition of the updates to the school calendar for 2020-2021. Carried unanimously.

At 5:01 p.m., Reyes joined the meeting.
