*All awards are one-time scholarships - distributed in July/August prior to the first year of college. The scholarship checks will be distributed directly to the student by Dave Hughes (on behalf of the MOC-FV Foundation) from NW Bank in Orange City after he receives a copy of the first college bill from the student prior to July 19.

___ **Paul Aykens Service Scholarship** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply; service to school, community, church; scholarship; activity involvement; honors/awards; character; any college; ACT score; GPA; transcript; 2 @ \$750 each

___ **Todd and Connie Barry Health/BB Scholarship** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply with additional consideration given to boys'/girls' BB player and/or future health-related career; moral

and Christian character; attitude and sportsmanship; leadership; citizenship; involvement; grades; ACT score; transcript; any college; \$500

___ **Pat Hansen Iowa Community College Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend any Iowa community college; \$500

___ **Gail Marincovich Creative Arts Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors with a passion for arts; involvement in arts; future college major and career in the arts; any college; “arts” – writing, theatre, visual arts, literature, speech, dance, or music; \$500

**Extra essay question for this Marincovich Scholarship - Tell about your passion for the ARTS.

___ **Mark Gunderson Character Athlete Scholarship** - all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply with additional consideration given to MOC-FV athletic involvement, displaying high levels of character, sportsmanship, and leadership on and off the court/field/etc, probable college athletic participation; \$1500

___ **Mulder Auto Business Scholarship** - any MOC-FV senior student that plans to attend any level of college (2-4 years) and pursue a degree in business; student has shown initiative, drive, and entrepreneurial interest while working in a local business while in high school; \$500

___ **Patricia Ver Steeg-Fedders Healthcare Scholarship** – all MOC-FV seniors are eligible to apply with additional consideration given to those pursuing a degree and career in healthcare; scholarship; activity involvement; character; community involvement; any college; GPA; ACT; up to \$500 each

___ **Harding Family Scholarship** - Multiple scholarships up to \$2,500 will be awarded to graduating seniors with the total amount of each award dependent upon the annual proceeds received. Any senior may apply, but additional consideration will be given to students interested in pursuing areas of study in agriculture and life sciences. (examples: agronomy, agriculture, agri-business, agri-technology, ag-education, turf management animal science, biology, nutrition, genetics and microbiology, and other earth/plant science majors may also be considered.) Awards based upon: major, college plans to any college, activities/employment/service, financial need. (a total of \$7494 was distributed in 2020)

___ **Perseverance Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend any college – **an extra essay question is asked for the Perseverance Scholarship – Tell about a challenging or difficult circumstances that you have overcome in your life and tell how that experience helped you become a stronger and/or better person today. One or more may be awarded; 1-3 @ \$500 each

***Next 2 - Recipients MUST attend Northwestern College ONLY!**

___ **Sheila Janssen Memorial Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend Northwestern College, who have been active in band during high school, and who excel academically, are encouraged to apply; GPA, ACT; \$1,000

___ **Jim Kleis Memorial Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend Northwestern College with a major in teacher education; based upon - GPA, ACT; \$750

___ **Warren DeVries Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend Northwestern College are eligible to apply; scholarship; activity involvement; honors/awards; community activities; service; character; attending NWC; GPA; ACT; 2 @ \$500 each

***Next 1 - Recipient MUST attend Northwestern College OR Buena Vista University ONLY!**

___ **Gordon McKinstrey Coaching/Education Scholarship** – any MOC-FV seniors planning to attend Northwestern College OR Buena Vista University are eligible to apply; future coach/educator; character; attitude and scholarship; citizenship; leadership; participation in sports and music; attending NWC or BVU; \$500
