If you do not see your activity on this list, you must get PRIOR APPROVAL from Mrs. Koenig.

#### **WILL COUNT FOR SILVER CORD HOURS:**

<u>Serving at Church</u> – church choir/praise team, working in the Church nursery, teaching at Bible School or Sunday School; not to fulfill a requirement, like confirmation

<u>Mission Trips</u> – consecutive days of a mission trip will count as a maximum of 10 service hours total

<u>Tulip Festival</u> – volunteering, planting/cleaning tulip beds, festival set-up (not on Service Day), Dutch Dancing, Dutch Dozen, Night Show performance, TF Court, Parade help; not required by a club/organization

<u>Service Done for a Non-Family Member</u> – for example: assisting a neighbor in need, babysitting, helping people move, yard work, snow shoveling/removal <u>without pay</u>

<u>Concession Stand Work</u> – If not fundraising for a school trip or to benefit oneself

<u>Helping Teachers</u> – during non-school hours, during the summer (not for pay), helping in room, making booklets or folders for kids, misc. jobs

Sack Pack Program Prep or local Food Bank/Zestos

**Donating Blood** 

Volunteering at a local nursing home

**Volunteering following a Natural Disaster** 

**4-H/Extension Service** – helping at day camps, Judge's helpers, Sioux County Youth Fair volunteer, not required by 4-H Club

**School-sponsored Activity Volunteering** - for example: Robotics helping library STEM programming, FFA food bank, prom decorating outside of school hours, etc; not during regular school hours, practices, or rehearsals

<u>Performing for the Community</u> – community band, community theater, NISO; (school activities do not count)

<u>Boy Scouts/Girl Scouts</u> – hours providing a service for a community project; not required for club's commitment

<u>Sporting Events/ Summer Recreation</u> - helping coach a youth team, refereeing a sporting event without pay, cleaning up gym following game without pay

**Serving at a Non-Profit Organization** 

<u>Mentoring an Elem/MS student</u> – if done on your own time (before or after school, open campus); not as HS credit

### Jr Fire Department Involvement

#### WILL NOT COUNT FOR SILVER CORD HOURS:

Any Activity performed during the School Day

Any Activity done for Pay or Compensation of any kind

<u>Concession Stand or Raising Money</u> <u>for a Club or</u> <u>Organization</u> – unless money is raised for a charity

**Working for a Family Member or Relative** 

**Any Activity to satisfy a Class Assignment** 

**Court-ordered Community Service** 

<u>Travel Time</u> – to and from an approved Silver Cord activity

- Students can only count a specific activity for a maximum of 10 hours per year.
- Service hours cannot be tracked by a parent/guardian on the Silver Cord Tracker.
