

MOC-FLOYD VALLEY COMMUNITY SCHOOL - - - November 9, 2020

The MOC-Floyd Valley Board of Education met on the above date at the Central Administration Office for its regular monthly meeting with all board members present. Also in attendance were Superintendent Adams, Secretary Dykstra and the press.

The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m. by President Jager.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink and supported by Reyes to approve the agenda as mailed. Motion carried unanimously.

An update was given on the new elementary building project by CMBA and W.A. Klinger.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Koerselman and carried unanimously to approve the following consent items:

- Contract for Carol Hofmeyer as a kitchen aide for 3.00 hours per day, not to exceed 129 hours per month, at a salary of \$13.73 per hour based upon the 1st step of the 2020-21 non-certified salary schedule
- Contract for Fernando Mercado as assistant high school wrestling coach for the 2020-2021 school year at a salary of \$2,696 based upon Level I of the 2020-21 supplemental salary schedule
- Contract for Kelly Bomgaars as clerical aide for 3.00 hours per day, not to exceed 129 hours per month, at a salary of \$17.13 per hour based upon the 5th step of the 2020-21 non-certified

salary schedule

- Contract for Bob Dorhout as route bus driver at a salary of \$27.66 per hour based upon the 5th step of the 2020-21 non-certified salary schedule

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Reyes and carried unanimously to approve the following board policies as revised.

Kleinhesselink left the meeting at 6:23 p.m.

The board reviewed the Return-to-Learn plan. An adjustment was proposed that those who would like to transition to remote learning would need to demonstrate medical need by a physician or mental health professional. Motion by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to approve this change. Motion carried unanimously.

Information was received about the Sioux Rivers Mental Health Grant opportunities. The district will receive \$75,908.68 in grants from them.

The first reading of Board Policies 503.1-503.7 was presented.

Motion by Reyes, supported by Koerselman to approve the application to the City of Orange City for annexation of the future MOC-Floyd Valley Elementary School project. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by De Jong and supported by Reyes to approve holding a public hearing on the proposed issuance of approximately \$400,000 school infrastructure sales, services and use tax revenue bonds. Motion carried unanimously. The REC has offered the district a 10-year interest free loan to allow us to install a geothermal system at the new elementary. The public hearing will be held on December 14, 2020.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review committee in the amount of \$81,282 for MSA for increasing enrollment in Fall 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reyes, supported by De Jong to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review committee in the amount of \$10,320 for MSA for open enrolled out students not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by De Jong, supported by Koerselman to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review committee in the amount of \$41,983.92 for MSA for providing an English language learner program for students who have exceeded five years of weighted funding in Fall 2020. Motion carried unanimously.
