- Contract for Mitchell Bomgaars as nighttime high school custodian and bus driver for 9.5 hours per day at a salary of \$21.20 per hour for building custodian based upon the 2nd step of the 2024-25 non-certified salary schedule and \$31.67 per hour for bus driving based upon the 5th step of the 2024-25 non-certified salary schedule
