Superintendent Adams shared changes that need to be made requiring the high school social studies curriculum due to the newly adopted social studies standards.

Superintendent Adams gave the board a legislative update. Supplemental state aid was set at 1%.

The SWOT analysis work was postponed until the April meeting.

Ryan Noteboom, Technology Director, shared the technology plans for the 2018-19 fiscal year.

The first reading of Board Policies 1004.4-1005.3 were presented.

Motion by Reyes, supported by Immeker to approve the purchase of a virtual application server from Sterling Computers for \$56,449. Motion carries unanimously.

Superintendent Adams presented the preliminary budget for the 2018-19 fiscal year. State Supplemental Aid for next year has been set at 1%. The proposed tax levies are as follows:

The instructional support levy is based upon ten per cent of the regular program cost with a rate of four per cent income surtax. The public budget hearing will be held on April 9, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. The notice of proposed budget will be published in the March 22 issue of the Sioux County Capital-

Democrat. Motion by Immeker, supported by Reyes to approve the preliminary budget for the 2018-19 fiscal year. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reyes and supported by Immeker to approve the following Budget Adjustment (Guarantee) Resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of MOC-Floyd Valley Community School District, will levy property tax for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the regular program budget adjustment as allowed under section 257.14, <u>Code of Iowa</u>.

Motion made by Immeker and supported by Reyes to approve the listing of certified staff members and their FTE, non-certified staff, and administrative staff. Once negotiations have been completed, contracts and work agreements will be sent. Motion carried unanimously.

At 6:53 p.m., motion was made by Immeker and supported by Reyes to enter closed session as provided by Chapter 20.17(3) of the open meetings law for a negotiations strategy session. Jager-aye, Immeker-aye, and Reyes-aye.
