An update was given on the Northwestern College track project.

The first reading of Board Policies 203.10-204.3 was presented.

Bids were received for the Hospers Boiler Project: Plains Boiler Service-\$286,744, Hander P & H-\$296,235, and Midwestern Mechanical-\$322,155. Motion by Koerselman, supported by Kleinhesselink to accept the bid from Plains Boiler Service in the amount of \$286,744. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Reyes and supported by Immeker to approve request to the School Budget Review Committee (SBRC) for Modified Supplemental Amount and Supplemental Aid for the 2019-2020 Dropout Prevention Program in the amount of \$375,218, for expenditures necessary to implement the 2019-2020 at-risk and dropout prevention program plans as approved by the MOC-Floyd Valley CSD school board. Jager-aye, Immeker-aye, Kleinhesselink-aye, Koerselman-aye, Reyes-aye.

Bids were sent out for a new food service van. Only one bid came back with the specifications requested. Motion by Reyes, supported by Immeker to approve the purchase a new food service van from Mouw Motors for \$30,755. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Kleinhesselink and supported by Koerselman to approve the transfer of \$33,000 from the general fund to the PPEL fund as a set-aside for the eventual replacement of field turf on our baseball field. This is the money that has been collected from Unity Christian for the past 3 years for field rent and the intention of this was to set it aside for future turf replacement. Motion carried unanimously.
